### CARE GUIDE - L1 Full Grain Real Leather



Leather is a natural product, each individual hide will be unique and in some instances show growth marks, scars, variation in grain and other natural characteristics which add to the style and beauty of real leather. These are unavoidable and should not be regarded as a defect. No two hides are the same and some variation in shade and texture is to be expected.

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# CARE INSTRUCTIONS GENERAL RULES TO FOLLOW.

- Vacuum regularly to avoid build up of crumbs, dust, dirt and other matter.
- Clean regularly by wiping over with a damp cloth, but not over wet, using circular motions until the dirty parts are clean. Then dry immediately with a soft cloth.
- If necessary a little soapy water can be added to the above for occasional spot cleaning. To avoid water marking do not over wet the fabric and ensure all soap residue is removed as a build up of this can cause fabric discolouration and odour.
- NEVER USE detergents, saddle soap, wax or spray polish which can cause irreversible damage.
- For more stubborn stains a proprietary leather care cleaners can be used following the manufacturers instructions.
- Clean spillages and stains as quickly as possible with a dry absorbent cloth, do not leave to dry in.
- After cleaning a neutral leather cream can be used to restore sheen following the manufacturers instructions.
- Too frequent or over enthusiastic cleaning or application of leather cream may wear away the upper, darker coat and affect the origional colour of the leather.
- When dealing with any stain it is important to always test an inconspicuous area of the fabric first to ensure the treatment will not cause permanent damage. If in any doubt specialist upholstery cleaning advise should be obtained.
- Do not allow body oils, alcohol based sanitizers, perspiration or hair products to settle into the grain of the leather as a build up of these will gradually damage and break down the finish.
- Avoid sharp objects such as belt buckles, studs and zips which can scratch the surface of the leather.
- Strong or neat alchol if not cleaned immediately may cause damage to the fabric.
- Protect from excessive sunlight and avoid contact with strong heat.

**IMPORTANT.** Although our leathers are tested for general contract/hospitality upholstery use they are desined to perform under normal conditions and with regular care as described. Please be aware that spills that are allowed to remain on the fabric for long periods of time can cause permanent damage. We accept that there may be environments where the use of this product is not suitable and other options may be more appropriate. In these instances we cannot be held responsible for the performance of the leather. **We do not recommend and take no responsibility for the performance of the fabric when used for piping**. Our 'limitation of liability' as detailed on our price list applies.
